

*Latest Developments in Sudan
during the period 05-12 April 2026*

Introduction

This report contains events in Sudan during the period from April 5th – 12th 2026. It reviews the most prominent activities of the sovereignty Council, the Cabinet, and other governmental corporations and official institutions. It sheds a light on the humanitarian situation and efforts to deliver aid and humanitarian assistance to the needy people. The report also stands out the systematic violations and crimes against humanity committed by the rebel militia in the several states. It also covers diplomatic activities and regional and international engagement with the situation in Sudan.

Activities of the Sovereignty Council:

- 1- *H.E. 1st Lt Gen. Abdel Fattah al-Burhan President of the Sovereignty Council and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces sent a congratulatory letter to Djiboutian President Ismail Omar Guelleh on the occasion of his re-election for a new presidential term. In his address commemorating the anniversary of April 6th, H.E. Al-Burhan renewed his pledge to the Sudanese people, affirming that the Armed Forces are committed to completing the nation-building process that began in 1985 and 2019. He emphasized the commitment to achieve the desired democratic transition. H.E. al-Burhan also addressed worshippers at the Sheikh Mohammed Khair Mosque and Quranic School in the Al-Fatihah area of Omdurman during Friday prayers, stressing the need to reject regionalism, racism, and hate speech.*
- 2- *H.E the Vice President of the Sovereignty Council Malik Agar met at his office in Khartoum the Turkish Deputy Foreign Minister Ambassador Musa Kallakhi, who is visiting the country as part of the 9th session of the Joint Political Committee between the two countries' foreign ministries. The meeting addressed humanitarian issues, H.E Malik Agar commended the efforts of the Turkish Government and people of Türkiye in supporting and assisting those affected by the war. H.E Malik Agar also met a delegation from the High-Level Mission for Solidarity and advocacy for Sudan, led by the Office of the Special Envoy of the Chairperson of the African Union Commission on Women, Peace and Security. He emphasized the Sudanese government's commitment to achieving peace and stability through Sudanese efforts with the support and assistance of the partners.*

The Cabinet Activities:

- 1- *H.E. Dr. Kamil Al-Tayeb Idris, Prime Minister, visited Al-Kadru Food Processing Complex, accompanied by the Minister of Animal Resources. The Prime Minister and his entourage toured the complex's departments and listened to explanations from the staff. H.E. Dr. Kamil Idris praised the complex's capabilities and commended the partnership between the Ministry of Animal Resources and the*

Defense Industries System. He directed the establishment of a specialized Innovation and Creativity Unit at the Al-Kadru Food Processing Complex. The Minister of Animal Resources also visited the Regional Training Institute for Meat Grade Testing and Health in Al-Kadru.

- 2- *Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation received the Italian delegation, headed by the Religious Advisor to the Italian Foreign Minister, at his office. The delegation's visit comes within the framework of the second phase of the "Italy for Sudan" humanitarian aid program. The head of the delegation explained that His Excellency the Foreign Minister expressed the Sudanese government's gratitude for the humanitarian aid provided by Italy, which reflects the strength of the bilateral relations between the two friendly countries.*

Humanitarian Activity

Visas and Movement Permits

- 1- *The Federal Humanitarian Aid Commission granted (43) entry visas to foreign and national voluntary organizations.*
- 2- *The Ministry of Foreign Affairs granted (25) entry visas to a number of United Nations agencies.*
- 3- *The relevant authorities issued (254) permits for movement to (11) states for a number of foreign voluntary organizations.*
- 4- *The competent authorities issued (179) movement permits to (10) states for a number of UN agencies and international organizations.*

Regional Activity

- 1- *The Government of Sudan welcomed US President Donald Trump's announcement of a two-week suspension of military operations against Iran. This step represents a positive initiative towards de-escalation and supports the diplomatic process to achieve peace and stability in the region.*
- 2- *The Government of Sudan condemned and denounced the Iranian attack on energy facilities in Jubail, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. It also affirmed that Iran's attacks on energy resources and infrastructure will undermine efforts towards stability and peace in the region.*

Violations by the Rapid Support Forces (RSF) Militia:

On April 11, 2026, the rebel militia and the SPLM-N (al-Hilu fraction) targeted the city of Dilling in South Kordofan State with a strategic drone missile, resulting in the death of six (6) citizens and injuries to seven (7) others.
